AUDIENCE bumped with BEYOND THE RIM then COLD BREW at the start, jostled with the former while in tight quarters the first furlong, backed up from inside on the turn, drifted out into the lane, angled outside MY HOUSE MY RULES upper stretch and could not improve his position. MY HOUSE MY RULES altered in early trying to keep a clear path, jostled several times with BEYOND THE RIM, advanced just off the inside on the turn, swung out five wide into the stretch and lacked the needed bid. GUN TRADER failed to menace in a wide trip. COLD BREW was bumped just after the break, stayed off the inside throughout and was never a factor.
